The National Legal Aid Service (NLAS) is a State Agency established by the Legal Aid Act, 2016 to give effect to Articles 19(2), 48, 50(2)(g) and (h) of the Constitution of Kenya. It is mandated to provide legal aid, advice and representation to the indigent, marginalized and vulnerable persons in the society.

.To implement the Legal Aid Act, NLAS has received funding from European Union through Programme for Legal Empowerment and Aid Delivery (PLEAD) to roll out legal aid services in 12 counties i.e. Garissa, Isiolo, Kisumu, Lamu, Mombasa, Mandera, Marsabit, Nakuru, Nairobi, Tana River, Uasin Gishu and Wajir.

NLAS seeks to engage sixteen (16) highly motivated Kenyans to undertake internship Programme for a period of six (6) months.

The successful interns shall be selected from applicants who possess the following qualifications:

Qualifications

- A Bachelor of Laws (LLB) Degree from an accredited and recognized University Or
- A Diploma in Law from an accredited and recognized institution.

Requirements

- A copy of the National Identity Card,
- Copies of Academic Certificates and Testimonials.

- Demonstrate good verbal and written communication skills in both English and Kiswahili
- Demonstrate a proactive attitude and willingness to learn and to be part of a team handling challenging assignments within timelines, and
